

Welcome to Strasburg Home Town Days Parade. The parade is open to all ages and to most entries. This is a non-alcoholic celebration and all participants will abide by this rule.

In order to make Saturday morning hassle free, below are some guidelines that need to be followed by you, the participant. We have over 100 entries and hopefully this will make the event preparation easier.

Things to remember:

1. **All entries must complete an entry form**, supplying the necessary information. If you have participants of various ages in your group, please use the age group with the most participants as your classification. Do not circle more than one age group on the entry. If your entry consists of 2 or 3 children, please include all names. Do not expect to add a name the morning of the parade or after the judging is completed. If you miss the deadline, **do not call me after 5:00 pm on Friday night**. Report to the Legion Hall between 8:00 AM and 9:30 AM on Saturday morning.
2. If your entry is part of a group or organization, please note on entry form.
3. No entry fee for parade.
4. Check in for parade entries – Legion Hall – corner of Burton Street and Westview Ave between 8:00 AM and 9:30 AM. Please designate 1 person from each entry to pick up parade number.  
FOOT TRAFFIC ONLY BETWEEN BURTON AND WAGNER STREETS
5. Placement of entries in the parade is made by the parade committee and all placements are final. No changes to the lineup will be allowed. Entry will be issued number. Number goes on passenger side and towards the front of the entrant (windshield, headlight, etc). No numbers will be issued prior to Saturday morning.
6. Beginning at Wagner Street and Westview Ave, street will be numbered to match parade entry – example:

Entry #10 will be between the two lines. You will be given a map indicating parade route. When lining up, please make sure you are in the correct place. When in doubt, ask someone for help. The lineup is important, as the announcer does not have time to check his list.

7. Each participant will receive a ticket for a free drink at the barbecue.
8. The parade begins promptly at 10:00 AM at the corner of Wagner Street and Colfax Avenue. There are starters for the parade at this corner. Do not enter the intersection until the starter has the area cleared of the previous parade entrant.
9. Once you have completed the parade route ending at the school, do not come back through the parade route.
10. ***As safety is our biggest concern, we are limiting all candy throwers to be walkers alongside the parade entry. No candy will be thrown from vehicles or floats in the parade. We are one of the few parades in the state of Colorado that allow candy and with your help; we will be able to continue this tradition. Safety is an important issue with the parade and anyone not abiding by the rules will not be allowed to participate the following year.***
11. Parade route is monitored by our own Crowd Control personnel. They will be keeping the parade route safe for the both passing entries and spectators.
12. The judge's stand is located on the right side of the street. All judging will be final. Ribbons are to be picked up at the BBQ at the school following the parade.
13. No burn-outs allowed.
